ENVIRONMENTAL TECHNICIAN TRAINING PROGRAM, FORT ST. JOHN, BRITISH COLUMBIA, CANADA

As part of the Meikle Wind Project, Hatfield supported Pattern Energy with its environmental impact assessment and environmental monitoring and management for construction. Pattern Energy offered Environmental Technician training to members of five First Nations communities in the project area. Trainees received certification through the Vancouver Island University and were employed as construction monitors. As the environmental manager, independent monitor, and First Nations liaison for the project, Hatfield recruited the Environmental Technicians and provided supervision, on-the-job training, and mentorship to Environmental Technicians.



REGIONAL CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM FOR HEALTH RISK MANAGEMENT OF PERSISTENT ORGANIC POLLUTANTS, SOUTH EAST ASIA

Under the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) funded project, Hatfield Consultants worked with national experts in Lao PDR, Cambodia, Thailand and Malaysia to improve the ability of government agencies in the South East Asia Region to manage POPs and POPs-like chemicals using a health risk-based approach. The Project improved inter-governmental cooperation on hazardous chemicals issues in the region. Key outputs and elements of the project included guided risk assessments, including field data collection training, practice and analysis, economic evaluation of health risks, a risk management toolkit, national training workshops, and a regional launch workshop.



DEVELOPMENT OF THE NILE RIVER AWARENESS KIT (NILE RAK), NILE BASIN INITIATIVE (NBI), UGANDA

The Nile RAK project promoted the sustainable management and use of resources within the Nile Basin. The NBI consists of a regional partnership of nine African countries including Sudan, Burundi, Rwanda, Tanzania, Kenya, Uganda, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Egypt, and Ethiopia. Key project activities included the development of educational and awareness-raising programs in environmental and water management delivered through an interactive, multimedia CD-ROM learning tool; development of Earth Observation applications and map products for regional environmental monitoring and management; and raising awareness through workshops, posters, and brochures.
