ABORIGINAL RELATIONS, TUMBLER RIDGE WIND ENERGY PROJECT

Hatfield managed this project through the per-operations phase which included ensuring compliance with permit conditions and additional monitoring surveys. This multi-year process included micro-siting of project infrastructure and environmental monitoring through the construction phase. As the owner's lead environmental and social consultant, Hatfield continues to engage with government agencies and the impacted First Nations to ensure monitoring is transparent and in accordance with accepted standards.



SOCIAL MAPPING FOR INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT, INDONESIA

Hatfield used participatory rural appraisal (focus group discussions and key informant interviews) and community mapping to determine communities' traditional resource use and practice, land use and tenure, and social structures. Information collected included traditional ecological knowledge, household consumption of fish, wildlife, and reliance on non-timber forest products for livelihoods. This study provided critical socio-economic information to benchmark the social impact assessment for proposed infrastructure projects in rural Indonesia.



GOLDEN EARS BRIDGE PROJECT

Hatfield consulted with First Nations during the planning, design and construction phases of the Golden Ears Bridge Project. On behalf of Translink Hatfield played a key role in developing opportunities for the Katzie First Nation involvement in construction phase activities. For example, through their development company Katzie First Nation members undertook archeological studies for the project and developed and implemented archaeological site mitigation measures. The Katzie First Nation also undertook habitat compensation initiatives for the Project.
